Introduction to HTML	the internet, the World Wide Web, HTML and XHTML, code standards and accessibility
Tags and Nesting	how HTML uses tags, tag requirements for XHTML
Create an Page	HTML Tags, required HTML page elements, required XHTML page elements, levels of XHTML, displaying a page in a browser
Working with Text	using tags for page layout and emphasising text, using special characters, adding comments
Tag Attributes	how HTML uses attributes, attribute requirements for XHTML
Meta Tags	what a meta tag is, using meta tags to provide information about a page, search engines and meta tags,
Hyperlinks	create a link to another website, another page, a location on a page, email links
Lists	create numbered and bullet point lists
Tables	create data tables, use table attributes to control the display, tables and accessibility
Images	suitable image types, image size and dimensions, adding an image to a page, image attributes, images and accessibility
Page Validation	using an online validation service to check that the code on a page is valid
